- 1. **1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 2. **Romans 3:23** for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
- 3. **Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 4. **Romans 8:28** And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.
- 5. <u>Ephesians 4:32</u> Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
- 6. <u>Proverbs 3:5 & 6</u> Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight.
- 7. **Romans 5:8** But God demonstrates His own love toward us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
- 8. Mark 12:30 & 31 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: love your neighbor as yourself. There is no commandment greater than these.
- 9. <u>John 3:16</u> For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.
- 10. <u>Hebrews 13:5</u> Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."
- 11. **Philippians 4:13** I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.
- 12. **Joshua 1:9** Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.
- 13. <u>Jeremiah 29:11</u> "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."
- 14. **Ephesians 2:8 & 9** For by grace are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast.
- 15. **2 Corinthians 5:17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.
- 16. <u>1 Peter 5:8</u> Be of sober spirit; be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

- 17. **Romans 10:9 & 13** If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved... for, whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved.
- 18. <u>2 Timothy 3:16 & 17</u> All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

- Psalm 37:1-8 ¹Do not fret because of evil men or be envious of those who do wrong; ²for like the grass they will soon wither, like green plants they will soon die away. ³Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. ⁴Delight yourself in the Lord, and He will give you the desires of your heart. ⁵Commit your way to the Lord; trust in Him and He will do this: ⁶He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun. ¬Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for Him; do not fret when men succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes. ⁸Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret- it leads only to evil.
- Matthew 6:9-13 ⁹After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. ¹⁰Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. ¹¹Give us this day our daily bread. ¹²And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. ¹³And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever.
